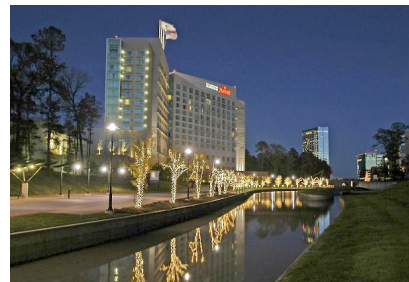

Optional Activities

Sunday, April 1st Canongate at The Woodlands, Panther Trail Golf Course

Panther Trail has been described as both “demanding and scenic” and was also ranked on of the Top 5 courses to play in the Houston area. Originally designed by Joe Lee & Robert von Hagge, Panther Trail was completely renovated in 2002 by Roy Case. Case has served as a design consultant for the Arnold Palmer Management Company since 1997 and his courses are known for their physical beauty, visual interest & quality of play. **The course is located only 2 miles from the hotel.**

The big takeaway from this is the opportunity to get answers/guidance specific to your situation.

Companies should bring their employees who are/would be responsible for preparing export orders for shipment. If you can’t bring these employees, come prepared with specific questions from those people. The opportunity to listen in on specific questions others may be asking could be helpful if you are new and are not sure what to ask. This is also an opportunity to interact with other PPC members who have interest with export orders and export shipments.
