KEYNOTE SPEAKER: AMY MYERS JAFFE



“Changing Landscape of Global Oil”

Amy Myers Jaffe is the author of *Energy’s Digital Future: Harnessing Innovation for American Resilience and National Security* and managing director of the Climate Policy Lab and a research professor at The Fletcher School at Tufts University. A leading expert on global energy policy and sustainability, Jaffe has previously served as the David M. Rubenstein Senior Fellow for Energy and the Environment at the Council on Foreign Relations and Executive Director for energy and sustainability at the University of California, Davis, where she led research on low or zero carbon fuels and transportation policy. Jaffe was also the first senior advisor for sustainability at the Office of the Chief Investment Officer at the University of California, Regents, assisting with the design and launch of their sustainable investing strategy. She currently is co-chair of the steering committee of the Women in Energy Initiative at Columbia University’s Center on Global Energy Policy and a research affiliate at the Center for Analytical Finance at University of California, Santa Cruz. Jaffe has taught international energy policy, business, and sustainability courses at Tufts University, Rice University, University of California Davis and Yale University. Jaffe is widely published, including as co-author of *Oil, Dollars, Debt and Crises: The Global Curse of Black Gold*, with Dr. Mahmoud El-Gamal.

A frequent media commentator, Jaffe was 2020 president of the US Association for Energy Economics and holds a Senior Fellow award from that organization for her career contributions to the field of energy economics. She is a member of the Global Future Council on Net Zero Transition at the World Economic Forum (Davos) and a member of the Council on Foreign Relations.

MARK BARROTT






